Steve Hennessey is the president and chief executive officer of the Pacific Maritime Association (PMA), with headquarters in San Francisco. As president of PMA, Mr. Hennessey directs the association's principal business activity, negotiating and administering maritime labor agreements with the International Longshore and Warehouse Union (ILWU) on the West Coast of the United States. He also oversees all operations, including registration of additional workers, arbitration of work issues/disputes, dispatch and training of the workforce and PMA staff. Additionally, he oversees payroll and the Welfare and Pension Benefit Plans.

Steve has 28 years of domestic maritime industry experience that includes overseeing vessel operations, procurement, terminal operations and labor relations activities. Steve joined the PMA in June of 2004 as Vice President Labor Relations, Southern California and was promoted to Senior Vice President, Chief Operating Officer, in March of 2005. Steve joined the PMA after working for Sea-Land Service and Horizon Lines since 1996, as General Manager, North American Operations. Responsibilities included terminal operations, intermodal operations, equipment and fleet administration, maintenance, and labor.
