Bonnie Lowenthal, a former state Assemblywoman, Long Beach City Councilwoman and Vice Mayor and Long Beach Unified School District Board member, was appointed in July 2017 by Mayor Robert Garcia to serve on the Long Beach Board of Harbor Commissioners, the five-member governing body for the Port of Long Beach, California.

Ms. Lowenthal has spent more than half her life in Long Beach, her adopted hometown, and has served the community as a licensed family counselor, mental health consultant and educator.

Her pre-political work is rooted in the local Cambodian community, beginning as Director of Planning for the United Cambodian Community in 1989. She helped initiate a sister city relationship between Long Beach and Phnom Penh and was an official elections observer during Cambodia's first municipal elections in more than 40 years.

Ms. Lowenthal earned a Bachelor's Degree in Sociology from the University of Wisconsin and a Master's Degree in Community and Clinical Psychology from California State University, Long Beach.
